For several weeks this past spring over 30 organizations in Durham, NC, and surrounding communities participated in a Racial Equity and Environment Workshop. It was offered by the Diversity and Equity in Environmental Programs (DEEP) Collaborative in partnership with the Durham Environmental Coalition. DEEP brings together local community organizations and university-led initiatives that address diversity, equity, and inclusion; K-12 education; and the environment.
